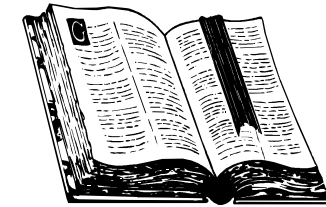


The Bible's Marvelous Unity
